2018-19 Tuition and Fees

All tuition is due in full when you register for classes. However, if you wish to spread the cost of tuition over several months, you have the option of a payment plan.

ALL registrations are “ON HOLD” until payment is made.

Please Note: *Failure to attend a full semester does not absolve registrants from their financial obligations to Veritas.*

Registration Fee Per Family Per Year:

- Nonrefundable
- \$125 for new families
- \$100 for returning families

Pay-in-Full Option:

- Registration and tuition is due within 7 days of registration
- Nonrefundable after the 2nd Wednesday of class semester schedule

Payment Plan Option:

- \$25 processing fee due at the time of registration
- \$15 late charge for every late payment, applied on the 16th
- Payments are due on the 1st of the month, if not received by the 15th, the late fee is applied
- Payment plan will be on your invoice and it is your responsibility to keep track of payments and due dates
- Nonrefundable after the 2nd Wednesday of class semester schedule

NOTE: ALL 1st semester payment plans must be paid in full by October 1st.
ALL 2nd semester payment plans must be paid in full by March 1st.

Co-op Assignment Duties: As we are a cooperative, working together is what keeps us functioning. One parent from each family is required to help fulfill co-op duties on campus. Most of the duties involve being a parent helper to a teacher in one or two classes. Over the summer, teachers may be contacting parents of registered students in order to find class helpers. Those who do not have a volunteer position by August 30th will be assigned a position unless they have opted to drop off their student for the day. ***The drop off option is only available for students in 7th - 12th grade and a “drop off fee” of \$50 per student applies.***

**Some Co-op Assignments are more involved and may require time off campus, for these bigger assignments, we offer discounts to help offset tuition. These assignments are limited, if you are interested in one of these let us know!

Drop off arrangements: Though we encourage parents to be on campus, we realize that this is not always possible. If you chose the drop off option, it is important to be on time to pick up your student.

- Students must be 12 years old and older to be dropped off.
- Parents agree to pick up their students **no later than 3:15 pm** (unless it's a class that ends at 3:30 then the time will be 3:45pm)
- **\$10 late fee** applies to late pickups

Nursery & Preschool: We do not offer a nursery or preschool at this time. All young children must remain with a parent. We do have a nursery/preschool room that you are welcome to use while you are on campus. When you register, please let us know if you will be bringing a little one, we need to have completed medical release forms on file for every child on campus. If you are a teacher and have need of childcare while you teach your class please let us know, we are able to provide care in those situations only.

Class Fees: The price for classes are shown on the class schedule and are per semester, per student. When you enroll a student in more than two classes the price drops \$10 for each class you add.

For example: If your 1st & 2nd classes were \$120 each:

3rd class would be \$110.

4th class would be \$100.

5th class would be \$90 ...*a total savings of \$60!*

Supply Fees: Supply fees and curriculum are not included in the cost of the class unless otherwise noted in the class description. Please see the description of the classes your are considering and take note of any required supplies or curriculum that you need to purchase for your student before classes begin. Most classes have a "supply fee" for supplies that the teacher will provide over the course of the semester. These fees vary by class, and are payable directly to the teacher. The amount of these supply fees can also be found in the class description. Any questions regarding supplies, curriculum, or supply fees should be directed to the teacher. The teacher's e-mail address is also located in the class description.

A Note About Grades: Grade reports will be issued for all core classes for 7th grade and up. You will receive these reports after each quarter from the class teacher. Remember: You remain the primary teacher.

Teaching: We realize the costs of co-op classes for a family can be daunting. Prayerfully consider the possibility of teaching to help offset tuition. You decide what class you want to offer and how you want to teach.
